You will need to label your personal materials with your name, but please do not label communal materials. Thank you!

For Personal Use (remember no licensed characters):

Proper Uniform (in line with uniform policy)

1 pair of inside black shoes (in line with uniform policy)

1 lunch container to minimize waste

1 backpack

1 Planner-must have monthly and weekly calendar for students to record events/assignments

Personal journal (any size)

1 sketchbook spiral bound 8 ½ x 11 for art

1 pronged folder or 1 ½ inch binder and 2 college-ruled *red composition* notebooks for language arts

1 pronged folder or 1 ½ inch binder and 1 *composition graphing (4x4)* notebook for math

1 pronged folder or 1 ½ inch binder and 1 *composition* college-ruled notebook for science

3-3 ring binders (~1 or 1 ½ inch) or 1 large D ring binder (~3in) for the Adolescent's portfolio model

1 package of sheet protectors for portfolios

1 scientific calculator (NOT a graphing calculator)

1 compass (best to invest in a better quality one that will stay open)

1 protractor

1 pair of scissors

1 ruler with both metric and standard measurements

1 pack of markers

1 pack of highlighters

Either 1 box of Ticonderoga pencils OR 1 package mechanical pencils with 0.9 lead (12 count)

For Communal Use:

1 pack of purple or green pens (6 count or greater)

1 pack of black Sharpie markers (4+ count)

2 glue sticks

2 reams of white copy paper

1 ream salmon copy paper

1 package of toilet paper (4+ rolls)+
